*The Tram transports visitors through Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge and into False Cape State Park. Upon arrival at False Cape State Park, riders can hike to the ocean or bay, relax at the visitor center, or continue on to the *Wash Woods Cemetery and Church Site Trail*.*

*Memorial Day – Labor Day
Tram Runs Daily*

*Labor Day – September 31
Tram Runs Fridays,
Saturdays, & Sunday*

October – Call for dates

The hike to Wash Woods is a fairly difficult one mile hike in soft sand.
