## **Funding Finds**

- Virginia Department of Education is offering up to \$15,000 in incentives to recruit and retain STEM teachers in high-need schools; applications are <u>due by December 6, 2024.</u>
- The Chesapeake Bay Trust's Environmental Education Grant Program is open for applications, offering up to \$40,000 for projects across Maryland to support environmental literacy and MWEE implementation; applications are <u>due by December 12, 2024.</u>
- The Office of Environmental Education will open its \$250,000 Meaningful Watershed Educational Experience (MWEE) grant this December, with applications <u>due in March, 2025.</u>
