
## **Element Occurrences of Virginia**

**Element Occurrence** The Virginia DCR-Natural Heritage Program manages an inventory of rare, threatened, and endangered plant and animal species, significant caves and exemplary natural **Density** communities across the Commonwealth. Locations of these Natural Heritage resources are known as Element occurrences (EOs). Knowing the locations and condition of Eos Very High provides information vital to ranking species rarity; understanding areas of high High biodiversity and ecological importance; and making well-informed conservation decisions. Medium This map displays the density of EOs in each jurisdiction of the Commonwealth using Low data up to June 2024. The total number of EOs in each jurisdiction were divided by the total number of acres in each jurisdiction. Thus, EOs that crossed jurisdictional Very Low boundaries were counted once for each locality. The results were log transformed None (In) to create relative density ranks for each jurisdiction, allowing a quick assessment of the distribution of EOs throughout the Commonwealth.
