Choose one of the following programs to be presented to your family or group during an available time! Each program is roughly 1 hour long.

- Toads, Turtles, and Snakes!: Get up close and personal with our beloved wildlife ambassadors. You'll discover these animals' habitats, diets, and more! This program is great for ages 2 to 102. This program is held in the visitor center. Seating is limited, so please be prepared to stand if you are able.
- Guided Hike on Redtail Ridge: Enjoy towering trees and the rustle of wildlife as you make your way to the overlooks on Redtail Ridge one of the most pristine views in the park. We'll meet at the Cabin Connector Trailhead and hike about 2 miles round trip on easy terrain. This program may last more than an hour depending on abilities.
- The Mighty Gundalow: Discover the fascinating history about the gundalows that used to dominate the Shenandoah River. After the program, your group will split up in team sand see who can build the better gundalow! This program will meet at the River Bend Discovery Center.
- Smokey Bear Said What?: Fire is an important part of a healthy forest. What happens when human actions alter this pattern? In this program, you will learn about fire ecology while also learning how to build a safe campfire! We will meet at the River Bend Discovery Center
- Fashion a Fish: The Shenandoah River is known for its bass, sunfish, catfish, and musky. Did you know that all of these fish have different styles of tails, mouths, and
- body shapes that allow them to thrive in different sections of the river? During this program, your group will practice their fish ID skills and see if they can design the most adaptable fish! This program will meet at the River Bend Discovery Center.
